THE VENUE

Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Indoor Stadium is an indoor stadium located on the campus of Goa University at Taleigao, Goa, India. The stadium has a seating capacity of 4000. It cost 82 crore and was built in 11 months which is a record for the construction of an indoor stadium of international standard. With a 131-metre sheet, the stadium is Asia's first stadium which has the longest single-sheet roof. Facilities includes air conditioning, dope control and medical rooms, media centre, state-of-the-art-acoustics, HD compliant arena lighting, Broadcast room, Delegates area, Dope control rooms, Medical rooms, VIP Lounge, Media Tribune and Media working stations, Press Conference area, Mixed zone area, CCTV camera and parking facilities.

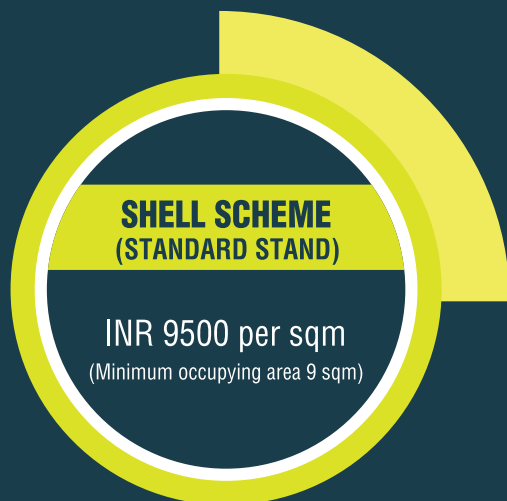

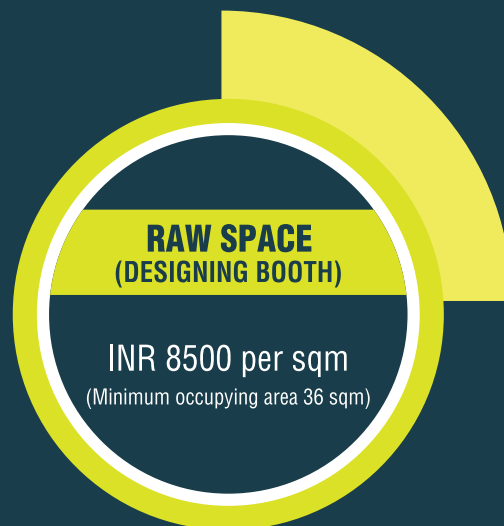

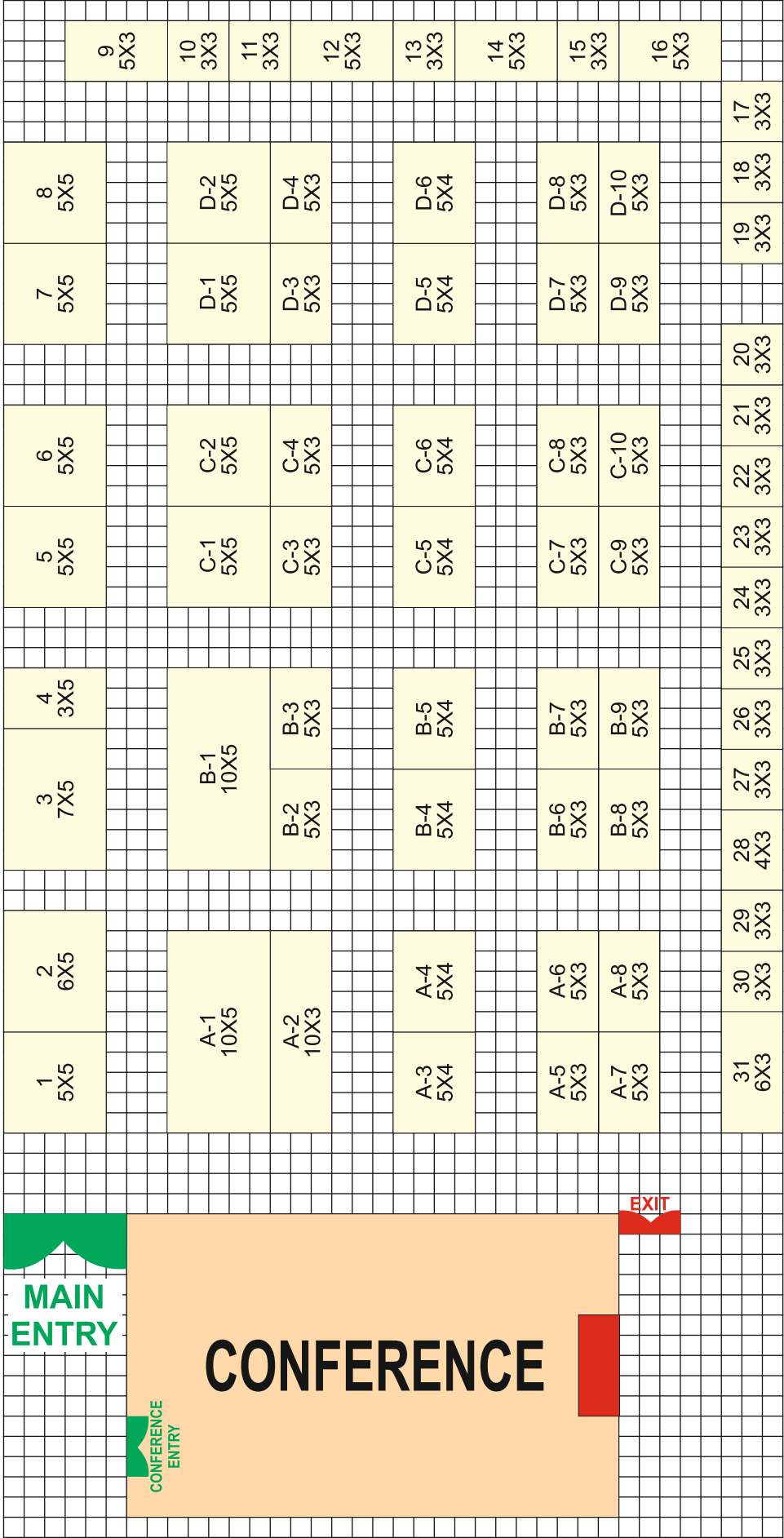
